Minutes: Minutes of the November 14, 2014 meeting were read. Alison Parker motioned that we approve the minutes. Marci LeMonnier seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Business:

- 1. Mr. Darren Johnson—Dr. Johnson and his family were in a serious car accident over the Winter Holiday break. Mrs. Johnson was seriously injured and will require extensive hospitalization. Dr. Johnson has been with his and family members, but is expected to return to work on January 20, 2015.
- 2. mClass Proposal—Dalene Owens presented to the council information about mClass. mClass is a program that works hand in hand with the DIBELS testing to inform teachers about how they can use the information. The school currently has access to the mCLass program for the 1^s-3rd grades and Dalene and Adele Youd are requesting money for the 4th -6th grades implementation. Dalene and Adele believe it would cost about \$3000. Adele will find out the actual cost and if it is a recurring cost.
- 3. Trust Lands Money—There are several choice items on the Trust Lands list for the council to choose from when deciding how to spend the money. They agreed that they needed to start by getting a feel of everyone's priority list.

•Alison feels that professional development and funding the technology specialist should be priorities.

•Justine feels that technology specialist and mCLass would be her priorities.

•Marci feels that we should ask the teachers.

- •Taz Murray stated that the school board would support more professional development.
- Tamela's list would be technology specialist, technology professional development, and mClass.Kori would support the technology specialist, Promethean boards and all the equipment up and working.

Adele was asked to find the cost of Fran and how much of the cost does the Trust Lands Money fund. (Fran makes \$17.61/hour. She works 25 hours for 40 weeks which brings us to a total of approximately \$16,000)

Adele was also asked to find out the cost of bulbs and such. Tiffany McCloud felt that \$1200 would more than cover the costs.

Adele was also asked to find the type of professional development the teachers would like

have at Canyon Crest.

- 4. Fund Raiser—The council determined that there would be no fundraiser sponsored by them this year.
- 5. Advanced Students—The council is conscience of our advanced students. They would like to look for more ways to advance their educational experience at Canyon Crest. Along those lines, Canyon Crest continues to need additional Spanish books.
