**Business:** 

1. Chad Duncan and J.P. Pontious were at the council meeting representing the district technology committee to introduce to the council House Bill 213-Internet Filtering. The school community councils are in charge of the 3 requirements of the bill. The 3 requirements are: Internet filtering, Internet safety, a public meeting. The problem with web filtering is that people either under-block or over-block. This leads to a false sense of security and someone will always get around the block. We've seen that very thing here at Canyon Crest. Every state has it's own set of standards which makes it hard to do anything on the national level. It is the School Community Council's responsibility to have a internet safety plan. Canyon Crest currently uses Net Smartz to educate every student about the dangers of using the Internet. The motion to appoint Erica Mildenhall as the 3<sup>rd</sup> teacher was made by Stephenie Larsen and seconded by Marci LeMonnier. The vote was again unanimous in the affirmative.
