Goal Proposal

By May 2024, 87% of students will score benchmark (grade level) and above according to the Acadience reading assessment and 80% of students will score benchmark (grade level) and above according to the Into Math math assessment.

Action Plan Steps and Expenditures Proposal

- 1. Support Tier 1 instruction for teachers with large class sizes by providing a classroom instructional assistant, as needed.
- 2. Increase effectiveness of Tier 2 and 3 interventions in areas of reading, math, and language development (for multilingual learners) by providing interventionist instructional assistants.
- 3. Teachers will routinely reflect on academic data with grade level PLC teams, including beginning-of-year (BOY), middle-of-year (MOY), and end-of-year (EOY) assessment outcomes.
- *Estimated \$64,728.00 for classroom and interventionist instructional assistants.
- 4. Teachers will use Pathways of Progress (POP) in Acadience to make and set reading goals for students.
- 5. Teachers will receive professional development on supporting students who have unique learning needs (e.g., multilingual learners).
- 6. LAND Trust funds will also support professional development experiences in- and out-of-state, which may include Solution Tree, PLC at Work, and AVID Summer Institute/National Conference. *Estimated \$7,013.98 for professional development opportunities
- 7. Leftover and rollover LAND Trust funds will be used for instructional assistants, professional development, positive behavior interventions and supports (PBIS), and internet safety. *For PBIS and internet safety, no more than \$7,000 will be spent.
