

WHEN TO KEEP YOUR STUDENT HOME



Temperature over 100.4

Must be fever free for 24 hrs without the use of fever reducing medication

Vomiting/Diarrhea

Must be free of vomiting/diarrhea for at least 24 hours



Persistent Cough

Cough lasting more than 3-4 days

Strep Throat

Any bacterial infection should be treated for at least 24 hours before returning to school



Pink Eye

Should be evaluated by a health care provider. If antibiotics are prescribed, must be treated for at least 24 hours before returning to school

Skin Rash

Any rash that may be due to an infection should be evaluated by a health care provider



Head Lice

Students with live bugs should receive treatment, then return to school. We *do not* have a No-Nit Policy.

This covers many common illnesses, there may be other illnesses that require your student to stay home. Contact the health room for questions.
